Dear Families,

I do hope you had a restful and enjoyable half term. It has been wonderful to see the children back in good spirits and ready to learn. The weather has been quite changeable this week, but we are thankful that the recent storms have not impacted upon the school and today is glorious!

### Covid update

Today I had a Local Authority briefing as to the measures we need to take under the guidance released by the DfE yesterday. The regulations in general society have been relaxed to the point that self-isolation periods are now not necessary. Whilst thankfully rates are on the decline, they are still higher locally than nationally and higher than January 2021. We are removing the request for you to wear masks outside when picking up or dropping off children (unless you would like to) but will still retain that requirement for in school visits for the short term.

We are also making plans to open up more widely in the future. The parent information meetings and class assemblies over the next two weeks will be recorded still as we appreciate it would be challenging for families to get time off work at short notice and the Local Authority are still expecting rates to increase following the half term holiday. We hope that we will be able to host the Spring Concert at the end of term with an audience and the summer term is looking much more positive so long as the situation continues to improve.

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
### Displays around the school
