Dear Parents,

I hope you all had a good half term, the children seem refreshed and ready to learn and have completed some great work already this week. The Key Stage 2 trip to the Natural History Museum in London was a wonderful experience for the children, and although I don't think anyone enjoyed the road delays there or back, the children were very excited about relaying their knowledge and understanding—the earthquake simulator was a highlight for a lot of children! Squirrels are also out and about next week, this time visiting Wimpole Hall farm to continue their learning about farms and animals and their habitats. I hope they have a great time, thank you to all the parents who are helping out on any of these excursions.

Last half term I delivered a phonics and reading session for parents and this half term would like to deliver another one for parents about calculation and maths. This will include ways to help at home, the progression of calculation from Early Years to Year Six and ideas for future provision and projects we are aiming to be involved in.
