Dear Parent/Carer,

Welcome back everybody, I hope you had a restful and enjoyable summer holiday. Already this term Badger class have had a fun trip den building at Anglesey Abbey and children are learning about their new topics, having settled in really well.

There have been quite a few positive premises changes throughout the school. Parking

Phonics and Reading Information Morning

Last year we conducted a phonics information morning for parents with children in Squirrel and/or Fieldmice classes. We will also be explaining the new DfE times tables test. This will be at 8.50am on **4th October**. We hope that you will be able to attend.

You are invited to our Harvest Service on **Tuesday 9th October**, to be held at **2.15 pm** in **Little Wilbraham Church**. The children will be collecting items for Jimmy's Cambridge including fruit and veg, canned goods, condiments and jams / spreads. They are also happy to receive dried produce such as; coffee, drinking chocolate, sugar and biscuits, etc. Please could children bring their Harvest gifts in to school on the Tuesday morning and we will arrange to get them to the Church. We hope you can join us, every class will be showing some of their artwork and poetry related to Harvest during the service.


